



Carol Anthony (John) Davidson is senior vice president, controller and chief accounting officer of Tyco International. He joined Tyco in January 2004 as part of the new management team and is responsible for overseeing financial reporting, internal controls and accounting policy across Tyco's global operations. Davidson played a key leadership role in planning and executing the spin-off of Tyco's healthcare and electronics businesses, which was completed on June 29, 2007.

Prior to joining Tyco, Davidson was vice president, Audit, Risk and Compliance for Dell Inc. During his seven-year career at Dell Inc. he served in other senior capacities including chief compliance officer, vice president and corporate controller and vice president of Internal Audit.

In addition, Davidson spent sixteen years with Eastman Kodak Company where he led the company's internal audit function, and previously served in a variety of accounting and financial leadership roles.

Davidson has previously served as a member of the Board of Directors of ESL Federal Credit Union, as well as a number of not-for-profit organizations, including St. Ann's Nursing Home, The School of the Holy Childhood, Garth Fagan Dance and the Austin Area Urban League.

He was recently recognized by *Black Professional* magazine as one of the "Top 100 Blacks in Corporate America."

Davidson began his career with Arthur Andersen & Co. He is a Certified Public Accountant and holds a Masters of Business Administration from the University of Rochester and a Bachelor of Science in Accounting from St. John Fisher College in Rochester, New York.
